An Act relating to state health insurance; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Sections 1316.2, as last amended by Section 15, Chapter 377, O.S.L. 2000 and 1316.3, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter 377, O.S.L. 2000 (74 O.S. Supp. 2000, Sections 1316.2 and 1316.3), which relate to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Act; providing references to new subsection; updating references; clarifying that certain retirement system members who reinstate health insurance coverage shall have any applicable amounts required to be paid by the retirement system paid to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board; allowing certain retired or vested members of the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System, the Uniform Retirement System for Justices and Judges, the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System, the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and Retirement System and the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System to elect coverage under certain circumstances; providing for payment of premiums; subjecting participant to rate changes; allowing election for dependent coverage; providing notice; providing references; amending reference; allowing certain retired or vested members of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma to elect coverage under certain circumstances; providing for payment of premiums; subjecting participant to rate changes; allowing election for dependent coverage; providing notice; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
