An Act relating to older Oklahomans; amending 56 O.S. 2001, Sections 3001, 3002 and 3003, which relate to the Coordination of Services for Older Oklahomans Act; modifying purpose and implementation; requiring development of a portal system; defining term; modifying dates; requiring uniform administrative rules governing transfer and release of confidential information between public and private agencies regarding older Oklahomans; providing for contents; requiring guidelines and development of a manual; requiring promulgation of rules and revisions thereof; requiring certain release and transfer; requiring confidentiality; providing for procedures, rules and forms; authorizing certain inspection and disclosure of certain court and agency records; providing eligible agencies and persons; requiring confidentiality; specifying penalty; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.
