An Act relating to public safety; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1550.41, which relates to identification of documents; expanding authority of Commissioner of Public Safety to issue identification documents; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Sections 6-102, 6-205.1, 6-301 and 6-303, which relate to driver licenses; authorizing military personnel to operate any class of motor vehicle when holding a valid driver license; prohibiting modification of some driver license revocations; setting time limit for certain modifications; prohibiting approval or attempt to issue unauthorized driver license; specifying grounds for termination of employment; specifying type of driver license revocation which shall be extended for subsequent convictions; and declaring an emergency.
