We, your Conference Committee to whom was referred Engrossed House Bill No. 2212, and Engrossed Senate Amendments thereto,
by: Corn et al of the House and Crutchfield et al of the Senate

entitled:

(Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System - amending 47
O.S., Section 2-305 - benefit computations codification - effective
date emergency)

beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
2. That the following Conference Committee Amendment be adopted.
 - a. Page 1, Line 9, restore the title to read as follows:

"An Act relating to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System; prohibiting reduction of certain contribution based upon response to mobilization for certain emergencies; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 2-305, which relates to benefit computations; modifying provisions related to computation of retirement benefits for certain persons; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency."

3. Add the following House Coauthors: Ingmire, Stites (J.T.), Askins and Hilliard of the House.
