An Act relating to public officers and employees; amending 44 O.S. 2001, Section 209, which relates to officers and employees of public entities who are members of the National Guard; requiring certain compensation for officers and employees of the state called to active service for Operation Enduring Freedom; amending 72 O.S. 2001, Sections 47 and 48, which relate to officers and employees of entities who were active duty military or are members of Reserve Components of the Armed Services of the United States; clarifying employment status of certain employees of private employers; requiring certain compensation for officers and employees called to active service for Operation Enduring Freedom; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-5.5, (Section 13, Chapter 381, O.S.L. 2001), which relates to the unclassified service of the state; adding certain positions to the unclassified service; and declaring an emergency.
