An Act relating to schools; requiring an applicant for employment to sign statement authorizing disclosure of unprofessional conduct; stating type of disclosure; providing immunity from liability; requiring request for disclosure from certain employers; establishing time limit for disclosure; providing exceptions from immunity; prohibiting employment without a signed statement; stating purpose for disclosed information; prohibiting disclosure of information; making disclosure a misdemeanor; prohibiting certain agreements or contracts that suppress disclosure of information about unprofessional conduct; making certain contracts or agreements void and unenforceable; allowing the expungement of certain information; allowing school districts to request further information; providing a definition; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
