CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker
and
Mr. President:

We, your Conference Committee to whom was referred Engrossed House Bill No. 2311, and Engrossed Senate Amendments thereto, by: Stites (J.T), Covey, Ferguson, Friskup, Hutchison, Kirby, Nations, Pope (Clay), Rice, Roan, Sweeden and Wells of the House and Morgan of the Senate

entitled:

(Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System - amending seven sections in Title 47 - administration of benefits - surviving children amending 70 O.S., Section 3218.7 tuition waiver - amending 74 O.S., Section 1316.2 - health care and dental benefits - effective date emergency)

beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede in its Amendment No.1
- 2. That the following Conference Committee Amendment be adopted:
 - a. Page 1, line 10, restore the title to read as follows:

"An Act relating to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Sections 2-300, 2-301, 2-303.1, 2-305, 2-306, 2-308 and 2-310.1, which relate to administration of benefits; modifying definitions; providing certain persons excluded from further membership in System; modifying due date of annual report; specifying applicable date for purposes of certain determinations made by Board of Trustees; authorizing payments to or on behalf of certain surviving children; specifying requirements for eligibility; modifying reference; modifying provision related to payment of certain death benefit; modifying reference for purposes of injury determinations; amending 70 O.S. 3218.7, which relates to tuition waivers; providing for waivers for children of certain members of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 1316.2, which relates to payment of certain amounts for health care benefits; authorizing surviving spouses of retired members to receive certain payments; authorizing continuation of health care and dental benefits by certain persons; prescribing procedures; providing for termination of benefits under certain conditions; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency."
