An Act relating to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Sections 2-300, 2-301, 2-303.1, 2-305, 2-306, 2-308 and 2-310.1, which relate to administration of benefits; modifying definitions; providing certain persons excluded from further membership in System; modifying due date of annual report; specifying applicable date for purposes of certain determinations made by Board of Trustees; authorizing payments to or on behalf of certain surviving children; specifying requirements for eligibility; modifying reference; modifying provision related to payment of certain death benefit; modifying reference for purposes of injury determinations; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 1316.2, which relates to payment of certain amounts for health care benefits; authorizing surviving spouses of retired members to receive certain payments; authorizing continuation of health care and dental benefits by certain persons; prescribing procedures; providing for termination of benefits under certain conditions; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
