We, your Conference Committee to whom was referred Engrossed House Bill No. 2637, and Engrossed Senate Amendments thereto, by: Toure and Pettigrew of the House and Henry of the Senate

entitled:

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 51 O.S. 2001, Sections 154, 155 and 156, which relate to The Governmental Tort Claims Act; modifying liability limits; providing for liability and claims for persons wrongfully imprisoned for a felony conviction and adding liability limit therefor; providing criteria; making liability both retroactive and prospective; providing for continued validity of prospective application if retroactive application is declared unconstitutional; modifying exceptions from liability; providing for when loss occurs; providing time period for presenting certain claims; and declaring an emergency.

That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1 that the attached Conference Committee Substitute be adopted.
