to whom was referred HOUSE BILL 2754

by: ASKINS Of the HOUSE

entitled

An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001, Sections 7303-1.3, 7303-1.4, 7303-4.6, 7303-5.3, 7303-5.4 and 7304-1.1, which relate to the Oklahoma Juvenile Code; authorizing graduated sanctions programs for juvenile offenders; specifying circumstances which require removal of child from home; defining term; specifying findings to be made when removing child from home; requiring determination of reasonable efforts for permanency planning; authorizing certain persons to be heard at review hearings; adding requirement for adult facility holding juveniles; amending 43A O.S. 2001, Section 3-415, which relates to certified drug and alcohol programs; exempting programs operated by Office of Juvenile Affairs from certification requirements; and providing an effective date.
