Mr. President:

We, your Conference Committee to whom was referred Engrossed House Bill No. 2772, and Engrossed Senate Amendments thereto,  
by: Tibbs, et al of the House and Laughlin of the Senate

entitled:

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001, Sections 7-114, 7-116 and 14-115.4, which relate to voting; requiring presentment of proof of identity when voting; providing for proof of identity; allowing persons without proof of identity to vote and providing procedure therefor; providing penalty for false statements; modifying requirements for voting if name of voter is not on precinct registry; and providing an effective date.

beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendation:

1. The House concur in Senate Amendments No. 1 & 2.
2. The Senate recede in its Amendment No. 3.
3. The following Conference Committee Amendment be adopted:
  - a) Page 1, line 14½, after "registry;", before "and providing an effective date.", add the following language to the title:

"requiring the State Election Board to follow certain procedure for complaints of suspected voter fraud; providing codification;"
