An Act relating to school transportation equipment; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-1104, which relates to obstructing the view of a driver and overloading a school bus; prohibiting interference with the operation of a school bus; requiring inspection of transportation equipment used by schools; specifying time period for inspection; stating standards for inspection; specifying who will conduct inspection; listing equipment to be examined and tested; defining term; establishing sanction for failure to comply; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
