An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 1-186, which relates to definition of vehicle; eliminating exception for devices moved by human power; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Sections 11-705 and 11-705.1, which relate to school and church buses; eliminating requirement that buses bear certain words; modifying citation; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-805, which relates to speed limits on motor-driven cycles; * * */ amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 40-105, which relates to required equipment on motorcycles and motor scooters; stating maximum height for handlebars; repealing 47 O.S. 2001, Sections 12-207, 12-209, 12-210 and 12-219, which relate to lamps and other lighting equipment on vehicles; repealing 47 O.S. 2001, Sections 12-302 and 12-303, which relate to brakes on vehicles; repealing 47 O.S. 2001, Sections 40-103 and 40-104, which relate to motorcycles; providing for codification; providing for recodification; and providing an effective date.
