AMENDMENT:

1. Page 1, Line 7-9 by restoring the title to read as follows:

An Act relating to insurance; amending 36 O.S. 2001, Sections  
635, 637 and 639, which relate to a Multiple Employer Welfare  
Arrangement (MEWA); modifying licensure requirements;  
specifying certain entities that must be in the MEWA;  
requiring filing and approval of certain documentation;  
expanding notification requirements; clarifying language;  
defining term; requiring certain proof; deleting obsolete  
reference; decreasing time period required for filing a report  
and providing for quarterly filing; expanding provisions of  
actuarial certification content; requiring MEWAs to annually  
report the MEWA's financial condition to employers; specifying  
time to send report; modifying conditions under which the  
Insurance Commissioner may require quarterly filing of a  
financial statement; and providing an effective date.
