CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to motor vehicles; providing an effective dates for certain sections of Enrolled House Bill 1081 of the 1st Session of the 48th Oklahoma Legislature; amending Section 11, Chapter 418, O.S.L. 2000, which relates to the Patrol Academy of the Department of Public Safety; modifying maximum number of cadets; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Section 8 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1081 of the 1st Session of the 48th Oklahoma Legislature shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Section 9 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1081 of the 1st Session of the 48th Oklahoma Legislature shall become effective upon the effective date of this act.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 418, O.S.L. 2000, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11. The Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, may conduct a Patrol Academy consisting of no more than ~~forty (40)~~ fifty (50) cadets.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
