COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-105.2, which relates to patrol schools; eliminating requirement for approval by Contingency Review Board under certain circumstances; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-105.2, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-105.2 The Department of Public Safety is authorized to conduct Public Safety Patrol Schools as may be required and within the funds available to the Department. Provided, however, that no such school will be commenced nor any funds expended therefor until each individual school has been approved for implementation by the Contingency Review Board or the Legislature has previously authorized that school.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
