COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-123, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 47, O.S.L. 1995 (47 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 2-123), which relates to sale of surplus vehicles; modifying description of items to be sold; adding entities to which Department is authorized to sell property; authorizing Department to conduct public auction; authorizing promulgation of certain rules; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-123, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 47, O.S.L. 1995 (47 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 2-123), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-123. ~~In addition to the authority for public auction under the sanction of the Department of Central Services, the A.~~
The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to make available for sale ~~surplus highway patrol~~ used vehicles and used emergency vehicle equipment to any federal, state, county or municipal ~~law enforcement~~ agency or public school district.
~~Vehicles may be offered for sale only after approval is given in writing by the Department of Central Services and an evaluation is made of each vehicle and a price set by the Department of Central Services. The Department of Public Safety may only receive the amount authorized by the Department of Central Services for the sale of the vehicle.~~

B. The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to make available for sale at public auction any used vehicles, used emergency vehicle equipment, and any property forfeited to the Department.

C. The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules for the sale and auction of used vehicles, used emergency vehicle equipment, and forfeited property.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
