COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to schools; designating November 11 as Veterans Day in public schools; providing for observance on certain days; requiring public schools to honor American veterans on Veterans Day; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-152 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The date of November 11 is hereby designated "Veterans Day" in and for the public schools of this state. In any year in which the date of November 11 is a Saturday or Sunday or classes are not in regular session, the public schools of this state shall observe the previous school day as "Veterans Day" as provided for in this section.

B. The board of education of each public school district shall ensure that each school in its district will on Veterans Day honor American veterans.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
