CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 6002, which relates to technology transfer centers; updating reference; designating constituted authority; requiring an agency, board, department, commission or institution to limit certain reporting; allowing entities to take certain action; clarifying intent; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 6002, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6002. Rural Enterprises of Oklahoma, Inc. ~~and the Central Industrial Applications Center are~~ is a constituted authority of the State of Oklahoma and as such is hereby designated as a technology transfer ~~centers~~ center.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3118 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For purposes of eliminating waste, a state agency, board, department, commission or institution that by law is required to supply reports or other documents, shall only supply those reports or documents to the named recipients in such legislation. If such entity has traditionally supplied these documents to all legislative members, then it may send a memorandum to such members of the

existence of the report or document and allow the members to request a full report or document. This section shall by no means diminish an agency's duty to supply reports pursuant to Sections 3104 and 3106.1 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
