CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001, Section 2-603, which relates to the Employment Security Act of 1980; authorizing filing of appeals by telephone; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 2-603, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-603. APPEAL TRIBUNAL.

The claimant or any other party entitled to notice of a determination may file an appeal from such determination with the appeal tribunal within ten (10) days after the date of mailing of the notice to ~~his~~ the claimant's or other party's last-known address or, if such notice is not mailed, within ten (10) days after the date of delivery of such notice. The claimant or other party may file an appeal in any manner allowed by Section 1-224 of this title or by telephone through the Commission's interactive voice response system or by speaking with one of the Commission's claims representatives. In order to be considered timely, filing of an appeal made by telephone through the interactive voice response system shall be completed by 12 midnight on the date it is due, and filing of an appeal made by telephone through a claims

representative must be completed before the end of normal business hours.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
