BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The State of Oklahoma shall appropriate from the State Treasury Nine Million Thirty-two Thousand Fifty-four Dollars (\$9,032,054.00) for the Low Income Heating Energy Assistance Program, Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for part-time Temporary or Contract Nursing Home Surveyors, and Twelve Million Dollars (\$12,000,000.00) for heating costs in Oklahoma public schools.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, the State Department of Agriculture shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The State Department of Agriculture for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitation on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
