A Concurrent Resolution condemning the terrorist  
attack on the United States on September 11, 2001;  
expressing support for the federal government; and  
directing distribution.

WHEREAS, a vicious and unprovoked attack was carried out against  
the government and citizens of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, while this savage attack was aimed at the United States  
in particular, it was meant to assail the core of beliefs that all  
freedom-loving peoples throughout the world hold dear; and

WHEREAS, America and the balance of the Free World will not and  
cannot allow these demented and fanatical elements to continue to  
inflict terrorist acts on humanity; and

WHEREAS, these extremists are supported and harbored by rogue regimes in parts of the world.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature unequivocally condemns the terrorist attack on the United States on September 11, 2001, and any other acts of violence aimed at American lives or property.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature strongly supports President Bush, our federal government leaders, and the brave individuals of the Armed Forces of the United States during this time of crisis and any and all appropriate actions the federal government may take to safeguard the security of this state, nation, and the world from the threat of terrorism.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature supports the United States Government, acting alone or in concert with other freedom-loving nations, to use any and every means at its disposal to track down and punish the perpetrators and any coconspirators of these despicable acts, be they individuals, groups or states. We further urge the United States Government to remain ever vigilant against the commission of these types of acts so long as they are a threat to the peace and security of humanity and pledge our continued support for such vigilance.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the President of the United States, the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, the Secretary of the United States Senate, the United States Secretary of Defense, the Governor of the State of New York, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Mayor of New York City, and the Mayor of Washington, D.C.
