A Concurrent Resolution creating the Task Force on Expansion Feasibility for the Oklahoma Transportation Authority; stating purpose of the Task Force; providing for membership and chair of the Task Force; providing for meeting procedures; providing for travel reimbursement; providing for staff assistance; providing for report of findings; and providing for termination of Task Force.

WHEREAS, this state harbors potential for expanding transportation resources in order to facilitate a more efficient economy and higher standard of living; and

WHEREAS, the possible expansion of transportation resources would serve to attract and accommodate future growth of business and industry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT there is created the Task Force on Expansion Feasibility for the Oklahoma Transportation Authority.

That the purpose of the Task Force shall be to determine whether the mission of the Oklahoma Transportation Authority should be expanded to include other forms of transportation and communication.

THAT the Task Force on Expansion Feasibility for the Oklahoma Transportation Authority shall be composed of the following members:

1. Five members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. One of the five members shall be appointed chair of the Task Force by the Speaker;

2. Five members of the Senate to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

3. Five members to be appointed by the Governor.

THAT the Task Force shall meet at such times and places as it deems necessary to perform its duties as specified in this section. Meetings shall be at the call of the chair.

THAT the legislative members of the Task Force shall be reimbursed by their appointing authorities for necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All other members of the Task Force shall be reimbursed by their appointing authority for necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

THAT the Governor and the Senate and the House of Representatives shall provide such staff support as is required by the Task Force.

THAT the Task Force shall set forth its findings or recommendations in a report to the Governor and the Legislature no later than January 6, 2003. The Task Force shall be terminated as of January 7, 2003.
