A Concurrent Resolution relating to the McCurtain
County ice storm damage and available federal funds;
and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, a devastating ice storm ravaged the landscape of
McCurtain County in December of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the ice storm of 2000 initiated an emergency status for
McCurtain County as the storm not only destroyed many trees and
blocked the roadways, but left thousands of homes and businesses
without power; and

WHEREAS, McCurtain County officials took the necessary and
proper steps to ensure a safe and efficient cleanup for its citizens
by applying and qualifying for any available federal funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Congressional Delegation of Oklahoma recognize the
extreme damage caused by the ice storm of 2000 and the cleanup costs
associated with the damage; and

THAT the Congressional Delegation of Oklahoma ensure that the
appropriate level of federal funds that McCurtain County was
properly qualified to accept be made available to the county.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to each member of
the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation and to each county
commissioner of McCurtain County.
