A Concurrent Resolution designating the bridge crossing the Canadian River on State Highway 4 between State Highway 152 and State Highway 37 as Schrock's Ferry Crossing; directing the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to place permanent markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Harry Schrock was a resident of the Mustang area during the 1920's; and

WHEREAS, Harry Schrock used a clever combination of common sense and innovation to develop an effective method of transportation to be used in the shipment of livestock and goods destined for Oklahoma City or for packing town. Recognizing the shallow waters of the Canadian River, Harry Schrock devised a horse drawn ferry to facilitate the much needed transportation for the Tuttle-Mustang area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the bridge crossing the Canadian River on State Highway 4 between State Highway 152 and State Highway 37 be designated the "Schrock's Ferry Crossing".

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause permanent and suitable markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing the name.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Secretary of Transportation Herschal Crow and Director of Transportation Gary

Ridley, to the members of the State Transportation Commission, to the President of the Mustang Chamber of Commerce, and to the President of the Tuttle Chamber of Commerce.
