A Concurrent Resolution expressing disapproval of the outer loop proposal issued by the Department of Transportation; directing the Department to withdraw the plan and consider alternatives; directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation has set forth a proposal for an outer loop to implement and act as a corridor for the southwest portion of the Oklahoma City metropolitan area with the intent to alleviate traffic congestion concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature expresses disapproval with the current proposal issued by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature directs the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to withdraw the current proposal of the outer loop for the Oklahoma City metropolitan area.

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation continue to explore other alternatives in developing a strategy for implementing an outer loop or any other mode of transportation that may alleviate traffic congestion concerns.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Secretary of Transportation Herschal Crow and Director of Transportation Gary Ridley and to the members of the State Transportation Commission.
