A Concurrent Resolution relating to a proposed amendment to a permanent rule of the Department of Wildlife Conservation; waiving the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed amendment to permanent rule OAC 800:25-7-17 relating to the taking of spring turkey; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature may waive the thirty-legislative-day review period for any rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2001, the Department of Wildlife Conservation submitted to the Legislature for its review, proposed amendment to permanent rule OAC 800:25-7-17 relating to the taking of spring turkey; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the substantive value and importance of such proposed amendment to permanent rule OAC 800:25-7-17.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby waives the thirty-legislative-day review period for the proposed amendment to permanent rule OAC 800:25-7-17.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor and the Director of Wildlife Conservation.
