NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature recognizes the Silver Haired Legislature for their contribution to the legislative process by originating concepts, programs, and policies that eventually are

transformed into state legislative bills, resolutions, and interim studies.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature thanks the Silver Haired Legislature for its contribution, supports the Silver Haired Legislature in its endeavors, and encourages all members of the Oklahoma State Legislature to give due credit to the Silver Haired Legislature for all bills, resolutions, and interim studies that originate with this organization.
