A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Commission for Human Services to enter into a multiyear agreement for replacement of the Department of Human Services mainframe computer system; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 85.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires state agencies to receive legislative approval prior to entering into lease-purchase agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Commission for Human Services has determined that it is necessary to replace its existing mainframe computer; and

WHEREAS, a lease-purchase agreement is the most cost-effective method of acquisition of a replacement for the existing Department of Human Services mainframe computer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Commission for Human Services is hereby authorized to enter into a multiyear lease-purchase agreement to acquire a replacement for its mainframe computer system.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Commission for Human Services, the State Purchasing Director and the Oklahoma State Bond Advisor.
