A Concurrent Resolution creating the Joint Task Force on Automobile Industry Equity; stating purposes; establishing membership; providing for reimbursement; providing staff support; requiring a report; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the state's motor vehicle industry is very important to the economy of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the state's motor vehicle dealers and rental car companies make considerable investments in their businesses; and

WHEREAS, competition among all segments of the motor vehicle industry is beneficial to consumers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature creates the Joint Task Force on Automobile Industry Equity to continue until February 4, 2003.

THAT the purpose of the Task Force is to determine if inequities exist in Oklahoma's current law regarding the purchase of the latest manufactured model used vehicles and the sale of used rental vehicles.

THAT the Joint Task Force on Automobile Industry Equity be composed of the following members: the Chair of the Senate Finance Committee, who shall serve as cochair of the Task Force, and four members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, one of whom shall be a member of the Oklahoma State Senate, one a licensed new car dealer appointed from a list of names submitted by the Oklahoma Automobile Dealers Association, one a licensed used car

dealer appointed from a list of names submitted by the Oklahoma Independent Automobile Dealers Association, and one a representative from a rental car company; the Chair of the Oklahoma House of Representatives Revenue and Taxation Committee, who shall serve as cochair, and four members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one of whom shall be a member of the House of Representatives, one a licensed new car dealer appointed from a list of names submitted by the Oklahoma Automobile Dealers Association, one a licensed used car dealer appointed from a list of names submitted by the Oklahoma Independent Automobile Dealers Association, and one a representative from a rental car company; and five members appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall be a licensed new car dealer appointed from a list of names submitted by the Oklahoma Automobile Dealers Association, one a licensed used car dealer appointed from a list of names submitted by the Oklahoma Independent Automobile Dealers Association, one a representative from the Oklahoma Tax Commission, one a member of the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission, and one a member of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission.

THAT the Task Force shall hold its first meeting not later than September 1, 2002, and continue to meet at such times and places it deems necessary to perform its purpose.

THAT members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed by their respective appointing authorities in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives shall provide staff support required by the Task Force.

THAT the Task Force shall report its findings or recommendations to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later than February 3, 2003.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma Automobile Dealers Association, the Oklahoma Independent Automobile Dealers Association, the Governor of the State of Oklahoma, the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission, the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission, and the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
