An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
2001, Section 29-203, which relates to size of
volunteer fire departments; increasing the maximum
number of members for certain municipalities; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 29-203, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 29-203. Any municipality having a volunteer fire
department shall limit by ordinance the size of the volunteer fire
department to not less than twelve nor more than ~~twenty~~ twenty-five
members for municipalities with a population of more than one
thousand five hundred (1,500); or not less than eight or more than
~~twenty~~ twenty-five members for municipalities with a population of
eight hundred (800) to one thousand five hundred (1,500); or not
less than six or more than ~~twenty~~ twenty-five members for
municipalities with a population of less than eight hundred (800).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
