An Act relating to chief executive offices; making an appropriation to the Office of the Governor; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor; stating purpose; making certain appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, the following amount or so much thereof as may be required for the following purposes:

Personal Services, operating expenses and extraordinary protection of the state	\$2,476,715.00
For the expenses related to the Secretary of Education and support staff	200,000.00
For the salary and benefit expenses of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs	75,000.00
For payment of official and necessary expenses during occupancy of the Governor's Mansion and to perform the duties of the Governor's Office pursuant to Section 7 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes	<u>58,000.00</u>
TOTAL	\$2,809,715.00

OFFICE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, the sum of Five Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Three Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$577,318.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Lieutenant Governor by law.

SECTION 3. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002 (hereafter FY-02) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003 (hereafter FY-03). Funds budgeted for FY-02 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2002, and must be expended by November 15, 2002. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2002, and not budgeted for FY-03, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-03 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2003. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2003, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-02, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-03, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budgeted work program revision removing these funds from the FY-02 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
