An Act relating to state government; granting management and control of certain space to the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission; defining space; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.6 of Title 73, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission shall have the management and control of the following space in the State Capitol Building:

The four offices and all space in the approximately 1,000 square feet of space on the first floor in the area designated as room 105, using January 1, 2001, as the reference point.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
