An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; which relates to memorial highways and bridges; designating a portion of State Highway 9 as the "J.M. Bailey Highway"; requiring the Department of Transportation to cause suitable permanent markers bearing the name; designating the bridge that crosses over Grand Lake on U.S. Highway 59 as "Sailboat Bridge"; requiring the Department of Transportation to cause suitable permanent markers to be placed at the north and south ends of the bridge; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1642 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 9, beginning at the intersection of State Highway 9 and U.S. Highway 69 in McIntosh County, extending west approximately two (2) miles shall be designated as the "J.M. Bailey Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1643 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge that crosses over Grand Lake on U.S. Highway 59 in Delaware County shall be designated as "Sailboat Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed at the north and south ends of the bridge.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
