A Concurrent Resolution commending Jimmie Cole for 39  
years of service on the Beaver County Conservation

District Board of Directors; wishing him well upon the occasion of his retirement from the Board; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Jimmie Cole was born on June 19, 1917, in Beaver County, Oklahoma. He grew up there and worked on the family farm from the time he was a very small child. Jimmie Cole has been a farmer and rancher for the last 60 years; and

WHEREAS, Jimmie Cole lived through the "Dirty Thirties" in Beaver County, Oklahoma, and as a result, dedicated himself to doing all he could to support conservation efforts to keep his area of the state from ever turning into a dustbowl again. In keeping with his commitment, Jimmie Cole has served on the Board of Directors of the Beaver County Conservation District for almost four decades; and

WHEREAS, Jimmie Cole retired from administrative duties with the Beaver County Hospital. He also served ten years as a school board member and has been an active member of civic and service organizations, including the Rotary and Masons. Jimmie Cole also served on the Board of Directors of the Christian Church; and

WHEREAS, Jimmie Cole has farmed and ranched in Oklahoma for over six decades and has served his community as a board member and member of various civic, service, and church organizations for over five decades. He is retiring from the Beaver County Conservation District Board of Directors after 39 years of service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
