House Bill No. 2665

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2665 - By: MILLER (Doug) and NANCE of the House and RABON of the Senate.

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Personnel Act; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-2.29, which relates to on-call classified employees; modifying on-call classified employees eligible for minimum work requirements; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-2.29, is amended to read as follows:

Section 840-2.29 A classified employee ~~working in an institutional setting~~ who is on-call shall receive a minimum of two (2) hours of work if the employee leaves the employee's residence and reports to work while on-call.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
