SENATE BILL NO. 564 - By: WILLIAMS of the Senate and ROACH of the House.

[ public health and safety - effective date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 90, O.S.L. 1998

(70 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 1-107.1), is amended to read as

follows:

Section 1-107.1 A. Unless otherwise specifically defined, technology is applied knowledge. For educational and governmental purposes, technology shall include, but not be limited to information:

1. Information technology, ~~telecommunications technology and implemental technology.~~ Information technology shall include including, but not be limited to:

- a. computers,
- b. computer hardware,
- c. scanners,
- d. multimedia material,
- e. facsimile,
- f. e-mail,

- 1           g.    computer software,
- 2           h.    CD ROM material or other magnetic media,
- 3           i.    computer simulations,
- 4           j.    video,
- 5           k.    the World Wide Web (WWW) or Internet,
- 6           l.    Listservs,
- 7           m.    multiuser domains, and
- 8           n.    other technology used in distance learning or distance
- 9                    education~~;~~;

10        2.    Telecommunications technology ~~shall include~~ including, but

11   not ~~be~~ limited to, local area networks and wide area networks~~;~~ and

12        3.    Implemental technology ~~shall include~~ including, but not ~~be~~

13   limited to:

- 14           a.    implements,
- 15           b.    equipment, and
- 16           c.    instruments or devices that promote the technology
- 17                    education process and are employed in the science or
- 18                    study of the practical, industrial, or mechanical arts
- 19                    or applied sciences.

20        B.    The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply

21   when related to the expenditure of public funds by educational, l

22   health and governmental entities.

23        SECTION 2.   This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
