



1 resolutions adopted by the board of county commissioners and  
2 governing body of the municipality employing such officers;

3 5. Any person holding a county or municipal office or position,  
4 or membership on any public trust authority, who is a member of a  
5 board or commission that relates to federal, state, county or  
6 municipal government and is created by the United States Government,  
7 the State of Oklahoma or a political subdivision of the state,  
8 except where the duties of the offices or positions conflict;

9 6. Any elected municipal officers and school board members who  
10 are appointed to a state board, commission, or similar entity if  
11 there is no compensation for such services other than reimbursement  
12 for necessary travel expenses pursuant to the provisions of the  
13 State Travel Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of  
14 the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 7. Any trustee of a public trust, who is appointed as a trustee  
16 of a different public trust or any trustee of the Tulsa County  
17 Public Facilities Authority who may also be employed by the  
18 Department of Transportation;

19 8. Law enforcement officers employed by municipal or county law  
20 enforcement departments or agencies, other than those law  
21 enforcement officers elected or appointed as sheriff, chief of  
22 police or some similar position in which they are the head of a  
23 county or municipal law enforcement agency, who are elected to local

1 boards of education; provided, the provisions of this paragraph  
2 shall not prohibit any law enforcement officer employed by a  
3 municipality having a population of ten thousand (10,000) or fewer  
4 people from serving as a member of a local board of education;

5 9. Any member of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division of the  
6 Department of Public Safety who is elected to a local board of  
7 education;

8 10. Any District Supervisor, Assistant District Supervisor,  
9 Team Supervisor, Parole Officer 1 or Parole Officer 2 of the  
10 Department of Corrections who is elected or appointed to a city  
11 council;

12 11. Any trustee or director of a rural electric cooperative, or  
13 port authority who is appointed or elected to a state, county or  
14 municipal board, commission or similar entity;

15 12. County employees who are elected as members of town or city  
16 councils;

17 13. Municipal, county, state or tribal law enforcement or peace  
18 officers operating under cross-deputization agreements with an  
19 Indian tribe or branch of the federal government;

20 14. Municipal or county law enforcement or peace officers  
21 serving in positions as campus police officers or campus public  
22 safety officers pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Campus  
23 Security Act, upon such terms and conditions as are mutually

1 approved by resolution adopted by the governing body of the  
2 municipality or county and the governing board of the institution of  
3 higher education;

4 15. State law enforcement or peace officers serving in  
5 positions as campus police officers or campus public safety officers  
6 pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Campus Security Act, upon  
7 such terms and conditions as are mutually approved by written  
8 agreement between the Commissioner of Public Safety and the  
9 governing board of the institution of higher education;

10 16. Municipal and county law enforcement officers serving in  
11 positions as part-time rangers under the Oklahoma Tourism and  
12 Recreation Department;

13 17. The Administrator of a Scenic Rivers Commission serving in  
14 the position of a park ranger under the Oklahoma Tourism and  
15 Recreation Department;

16 18. Members of the University Hospitals Authority;

17 19. Any person holding a state office or position who is a  
18 ~~noncompensated~~ reserve force deputy sheriff or a ~~noncompensated~~  
19 reserve municipal police officer;

20 20. Any person holding a state office or position who serves as  
21 a special assistant district attorney without compensation;

22 21. Any elected or appointed member of a local school board who  
23 is a member of a municipal planning commission;

1        22. Any elected or appointed member of a local school board who  
2 is a member or an officer of a volunteer fire department;

3        23 Directors or officers of a rural water district and chiefs  
4 of municipal fire departments or rural fire districts who are  
5 appointed or elected to an unsalaried office in a state, county,  
6 municipal, school, or vocational-technical school board, commission,  
7 or similar entity, except where the duties of the office would  
8 create a conflict of interest; and

9        24. Any person who is a dispatcher or confinement officer at a  
10 municipal jail who is a noncompensated reserve municipal police  
11 officer.

12        The provisions of this section shall not prohibit any person  
13 holding an office under the laws of the state or any deputy of any  
14 officer so holding any office from serving upon the board of  
15 Oklahoma Futures or upon the board of directors of the Oklahoma  
16 Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology. The  
17 provisions of this section shall not prohibit a member of the board  
18 of directors of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science  
19 and Technology from serving upon the board of Oklahoma Futures.

20        B. Any salaries, emoluments or benefits that would otherwise be  
21 paid by the agency or political subdivision to a loaned employee or  
22 officer shall instead be paid to the regular employer of such  
23 employee. The loaned employee shall in turn be paid regular salary

1 and benefits the same as if continuing regular employment with the  
2 permanent employer.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
