SENATE BILL NO. 936 - By: SHURDEN of the Senate and TURNER of the House.

[motor vehicles - authorizing golf carts to be operated by persons with a physical disability - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1151.2 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person with a physical disability as defined by Section 15-112 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes or designee shall be authorized to operate a golf cart if:

- 1. Such operation is within the boundaries of a park owned by this state;
- 2. Operation occurs during daylight hours only; and
- 3. The golf cart does not exceed speed limit in such area as determined by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
