SENATE BILL NO. 937 - By: SHURDEN of the Senate and SMITH (Dale) of the House.

An Act relating to fish and game; amending 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-114, which relates to hunting and fishing licenses; increasing fee for certain hunting and fishing licenses; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-114, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-114. A. All legal residents who have resided in the state for at least six (6) months may purchase lifetime fishing licenses, lifetime hunting licenses or lifetime combination hunting/fishing licenses from the Director.

B. The fee for these licenses shall be:

- 1. Lifetime fishing license, ~~One Hundred Fifty Dollars~~ ~~(\$150.00)~~ One Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$175.00);
- 2. Lifetime hunting license, ~~Four Hundred Dollars~~ ~~(\$400.00)~~ Six Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$625.00);
- 3. Lifetime hunting license for persons age sixty (60) years and over, Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00); and
- 4. Lifetime combination hunting/fishing license, ~~Five Hundred Twenty-five Dollars~~ ~~(\$525.00)~~ Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00).

1 C. The use of the licenses provided in this section are subject  
2 to those restrictions provided by statute and the regulations of the  
3 Commission. The lifetime hunting license shall be in lieu of all  
4 annual hunting licenses and all special season permits.

5 D. Nonresidents may purchase:

6 1. A lifetime nonresident fishing license. The fee for such  
7 license shall be Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00);

8 2. A lifetime nonresident small game hunting license to hunt  
9 game other than deer, antelope, elk, or turkey. The fee shall be  
10 Four Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$450.00); or

11 3. A lifetime nonresident combination fishing and small game  
12 hunting license. The fee shall be Six Hundred Fifty Dollars  
13 (\$650.00).

14 E. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a  
15 duplicate will be issued by the Department for a fee of Five Dollars  
16 (\$5.00).

17 F. A lifetime licensee shall not lose the privileges of such  
18 license by a subsequent transfer of residency.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
