

An Act relating to public health; creating the Long-term Care Central Complaint System Act; providing for short title; providing for legislative findings and intent; making certain facilities, services and persons subject to the Long-term Care Central Complaint System Act; providing for certain exception; directing the State Department of Health to establish certain toll free hotline and complaint system in certain manner; authorizing certain persons to file certain complaints; directing the State Board of Health to promulgate certain rules; providing for content of rules; providing for certain right and certain liability; directing certain facilities, services and persons to provide certain information to certain persons; requiring certain facilities to post certain number in certain manner; requiring certain state agencies to forward certain information to certain entity; requiring certain coordination in certain investigations; requiring certain state agencies to confer and coordinate for certain purposes; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-1923.1, which relates to the Residents and Family State Council and certain toll free hotline; removing requirement for certain hotline; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Sections 1-1912, 1-1914.1 and 1-1914.2, which relate to the Nursing Home Care Act; adding to certain list of certain violations; authorizing certain remedial action under certain circumstances; expanding authorization to appoint temporary managers; providing for receivership of certain facilities under certain circumstances; providing for petition, hearing and procedures; providing for certain emergencies; providing for appointment of receiver; providing for duties and responsibilities of receiver; providing for certain exemption from liability; providing for certain funds for certain purposes; providing for conditional license; providing for termination of receivership; providing for certain accounting; providing for certain disposition of certain funds; providing for certain liens; providing for certain liabilities and obligations; providing for retention of certain right by certain persons; providing procedures; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
