

An Act relating to DNA Offender Database; amending 22 O.S. 2001, Section 991a, as amended by Section 10 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2924 of the 2nd Session of the 48th Oklahoma Legislature, 57 O.S. 2001, Section 584, and 74 O.S. 2001, Sections 150.27 and 150.27a, which relate to powers of the court, registration of sex offenders, and DNA Offender Database; requiring blood or saliva samples be collected; including certain offenders in mandatory DNA testing and inclusion in DNA Offender Database; providing that deferred judgment does not require submission to DNA testing, with exception; deleting requirements for certain offenders to provide DNA sample by certain date; deleting obsolete language; and declaring an emergency.
