

An Act relating to mental health; amending 43A O.S. 2001, Sections 1-103, 1-107, 1-109 and 1-110, which relate to purposes and definitions of the mental health law; modifying and adding definitions; modifying where involuntary commitment hearings may be held; stating exceptions; specifying requirements for release of information regarding cause of death of a patient; specifying contents of valid written release; removing obsolete language; amending 43A O.S. 2001, Sections 2-103, 2-104 and 2-108, which relate to the Department and Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; removing obsolete language; specifying when certain board member terms end; modifying terms; requiring Board to establish system for resolving complaints; authorizing Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to appoint citizen advisory committees; amending 43A O.S. 2001, Section 2-202, which relates to powers and duties of the Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; authorizing designation of specific hours for certain admissions; amending 43A O.S. 2001, Sections 3-301, 3-302, 3-306, 3-313, 3-314.1 and 3-317, which relate to the Unified Community Mental Health Act; modifying citations; adding and modifying definitions; modifying responsibilities of Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; establishing procedures for certification of community mental health centers; authorizing application and renewal fee; stating standards for compliance; specifying certain information shall not
