

An Act relating to crimes and punishment; amending 21 O.S. 1991, Section 851, as last amended by Section 154, Chapter 5, 1st Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1999 (21 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 851), which relates to desertion of children under ten years of age; stating that leaving a newborn infant with a medical provider under certain circumstances shall not be subject to criminal prosecution; stating exceptions; requiring certain entities to receive a child and to provide for the physical health or safety of the child; requiring notification of local law enforcement; stating what information shall be required if requested; providing immunity for medical providers under certain circumstances; making newborn infant an abandoned child for certain purposes; defining terms; providing for certain tracking mechanisms; providing for sunset review; and declaring an emergency.
