

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1-111, which relates to length of school day; requiring district boards of education to adopt policies for Internet-based courses; specifying information to be included in policies; clarifying responsibility for equipment and Internet access; requiring approval of certain courses by State Board and district board of education for credit; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1-113, which relates to school district residency; authorizing districts to provide educational services pursuant to contract to children not residing in the United States of America; prohibiting counting certain children for average daily membership; authorizing non-resident district to provide certain educational services for children in out-of-home placements; prohibiting entities from contracting for educational services with more than one school district; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 8-104, which relates to emergency transfers; adding certain conditions for emergency transfer; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 11-103.6, as amended by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2886 of the 2nd Session of the 48th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to high school graduation requirements; authorizing certain Internet-based courses taught at technology center schools to count for certain academic credit; providing for incorporation of certain standards for certain courses; granting certain academic credit for successful completion of certain advanced mathematics or science courses; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1210.531, which relates to the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program; requiring test results for regular and alternative education students enrolled in Internet-based instruction to be disaggregated and reported; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1210.567, which relates to alternative education program abbreviated schedule; allowing district board of education to authorize enrollment in Internet-based courses on part-time basis for certain students; providing formula for calculation of State Aid for students enrolled on part-time basis; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
