Supp. 2000, Section 2002), which relates to the Rural Economic Action Plan Water Projects Fund; authorizing certain expenditures and transfers for certain purposes; exempting certain allocations of funds from budgetary limitation; making an appropriation to the Department of Environmental Quality; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations; requiring certain expenditures; specifying purposes; making certain appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
