

An Act relating to motor vehicles, professions and occupations and public health and safety; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 15-112, as last amended by Section 7, Chapter 189, O.S.L. 2000 (47 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 15-112), which relates to special parking privileges for physically disabled persons; adding definition; amending Section 2, Chapter 289, O.S.L. 1993, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 128, O.S.L. 1998, Section 6, Chapter 289, O.S.L. 1993, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 128, O.S.L. 1998 and Section 7, Chapter 289, O.S.L. 1993 (59 O.S. Supp. 2000, Sections 519.2, 519.6, 519.7), which relate to the Physician Assistant Act; modifying certain definition to add services which physician assistants may perform; construing act; adding definition; providing additional requirement for the supervision of a physician assistant; specifying when physician assistants may write orders or prescriptions for Schedule II drugs; specifying when physician assistants may perform health care services; requiring availability of physician assistant license and identification of person as a physician assistant; authorizing temporary approval of a license to specified persons; amending 59 O.S. 1991, Section 887.2, which relates to the Physical Therapy Practice Act; amending definition to include "physician assistant"; amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 2-312, as last amended by Section 6, Chapter 128, O.S.L. 1998 (63 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 2-312), which relates to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act; expanding types of drugs that a physician assistant can prescribe and administer; and providing an effective date.
