HOUSE BILL HB1003

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to workers' compensation; amending 85 O.S. 1991, Section 45, as amended by Section 34, Chapter 1, 2nd Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1994 (85 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 45), which relates to consideration of collateral sources of an injured employee; clarifying reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 85 O.S. 1991, Section 45, as amended by Section 34, Chapter 1, 2nd Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1994 (85 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 45), is amended to read as follows:

Section 45. A. No benefits, saving or insurance of the injured employee, independent of the provisions of this act shall be considered in determining the compensation or benefit to be paid under ~~this act~~ the Workers' Compensation Act.

B. No employee may receive temporary total disability benefits covering the same period of time as unemployment compensation benefits received by the employee as provided by the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
