HOUSE BILL HB1111

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; creating a study to remove tolls from the turnpike system; providing method of funding; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1736 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Transportation Authority shall set aside one cent (\$0.01) per motor vehicle, per toll collected from all operative turnpike roads upon any toll increase occurring after November 1, 2001. This shall not apply to sections of road under construction and being added to the turnpike system.

The money set aside shall be used to fund a study on how Kentucky has removed tolls from its turnpike system. This study shall be conducted by the Oklahoma Transportation Authority.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
