HOUSE BILL HB1359

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to children; establishing the Juvenile Violence Prevention Revolving Fund; stating purpose of fund; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7302-3.12 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Office of Juvenile Affairs to be known as the Juvenile Violence Prevention Revolving Fund. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of any monies appropriated or transferred to the fund and any monies contributed to the fund from any other source. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of Juvenile Affairs for the purpose of providing grants to school districts and nonprofit organizations. The grants shall be used for providing violence prevention programs to juveniles. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims signed by an authorized state employee and filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
